People of earth, (This is an open letter to everyone alive! I pray you copy and give it⁽⁹⁾ to everyone you know.)⁽¹⁸⁾

How do you feel about life in these troubling times? Would you like some good news bringing peace?¹ Peace today can be hard to come by. Sandy Thomas recently (Oct. 2020) said someone upset her young grandson by telling him the end of the world is here. What do you think? Most of us have heard the churches warn "the end" was coming (*Rom 13:11*) since our own youth. You though, do you think the tribulation could really be happening, now, in our day? From those warnings by the churches, most people can quote some of the scriptures where Jesus mentioned wars and rumors of wars, earthquakes and famine and pestilence and violence, all as being signs (*or the composite sign*) of the end.⁽²⁶⁾ Should we be surprised, then, some people are saying "the end" is now? Of note, after warning

about it for all these years, why have most <u>churches (and religious sects)</u> suddenly gone silent on the matter of the signs of the end? Sandy also said her grandson has faith in Christ and is "saved." My suggestion, and I believe Jesus's teaching, is for Sandy to encourage her grandson **the person might be right about this being the end of the old world system; but, and this is very important,** show him from the Bible where **Jesus said "the end" is a good thing.** (26 - Luke 21:28) "The end" is a wonderful gift to those who have faith in Christ. (8) (It's always sad when anyone has to suffer or die, of course, but the simple truth is: For peace to exist, those who are liars and other workers of lawlessness first have to die. The wicked are, in effect, already dying by their own hand! Disobedience to God and abuse of the earth has caused the tribulation we are enduring. **We have brought humankind to the brink of death; what God offers is deliverance!** Disobedience caused the tribulation [violence and suffering] of Noah's day, and, rebellion against God has brought our suffering as well.) Sandy's grandson should be helped to know and understand: He can actually rely on his expressed faith in Christ to protect him. Everyone, young or old, should know to continually read from and believe (build faith in) all the promises by

Jesus. *Christ came to teach* us how to pray⁴ and what to ask for; to teach **us to personally and intimately know his Father.**⁵

I feel compelled and driven by my need to tell every living person this truth (as should you): You can help bring an end of this world's suffering (help speed us to an end of the tribulation). Jesus himself said you can! He said the tribulation would get so bad, if God didn't step in to end it, no flesh would be left alive. (43) When, though, or why and how, would God step in to speed the tribulation to its conclusion? *Jesus went on to explain the good* news about his Kingdom would be preached throughout the earth, and then the end will come. (26 - Mat 24:14) That preaching work is how God is speeding us to the end. You can individually help get us there faster; if you assist in preaching that good news. What, though, is "the kingdom of God" or "the good news" Jesus said would be preached? He said his kingdom was not something people could easily identify using their eyes, and that the kingdom was already in their midst: The kingdom and/or the power of life exists in the words Jesus spoke. (34)-Jn 6:63 & (30)-Jn 8:31-32 Helping you scripturally understand what the "good news of the kingdom" is, then, is what this letter is for. Such an understanding only has value, of course, if it actually is what Christ taught. Whether to put faith in Christ is the choice you are making; (18) as building faith in what Jesus said is the purpose of life. ⁷ Take to heart the few scriptures footnoting this letter and you will understand and be able to see (through eyes of faith) the kingdom of God. You will understand: Listening to and building faith in what Jesus said is the very source of life. (34) Faith in his words is faith in "the good news of the Kingdom." (28) Exercising faith in Christ's promises will protect all those persons having such faith. (8)-Mat 8:13 So... It seems scriptural to say **vou can help** end the tribulation and bring peace simply by copying or printing⁹ this letter and sending it to everyone you know. Such "preaching" will help all people decide if they want God's kingdom. That's what has to happen **before "the end."** My wife Tricia asked me: "Do you really believe if everyone on earth would spend all their

free time reading and taking to heart the words of Jesus, all our problems would be solved?" Yes! Yes! Yes! That is exactly what I believe would happen; and, what I believe is happening. 10 Faith in Christ's words, you see, grants God's spirit. 11 God's spirit is power to effect change 12 (within God's will, of course)! 13 That probably means Christians cannot become rich or young overnight; (35)-Job 33:13~30 as everyone would then try and flock to Christ for the reward they see on others. "Our faith" can protect us, but it will not correct all the wicked. We don't have to worry about them. Doing away with the wicked is what God is using Christ and the tribulation to do. We only need faith! We need faith without seeing, ¹⁴ because we recognize disobedience to God always brings harm. Because of my warning about Noah, my daughter Rachael asked me: "Dad, do you really imagine you can compare yourself to righteous Noah?" Again, the answer is yes! But not just me. Jesus compared all his "latter day" followers to Noah. (27)-Luk 17:26-30 Followers of Christ, you see, will be survivors of our modern day (and final) tribulation, which is destroying the wicked (those without faith). God has not, of course, whispered in my ear to tell me these things are true. And, I cannot point to my blessings that prove they are. I can't even prove to you God exists. God has provided such proof, however, and that must be your faith. [Rom 1:18-23; Heb 3:4] If you do have faith in a God who is good, [Heb 11:6] the Bible, using the words of Christ, presents the only reasonable explanation of truth. So... This is my best attempt to express faith built on what I believe Jesus taught! And, my point is always: You must have faith, your own personal faith, in what you cautiously know to be the true words of Jesus Christ. (40)-Mat 7:15-20 Read this letter, and then, read Matthew, Mark, Luke or John to prove it is so!

Teaching obedience to his Father^{15 & (42)} is why Jesus came.¹⁶ Even if you are not fully convinced by me, but Jesus's words do strum your heart strings,¹⁷ send this letter of scriptures as a curiosity or as point of conversation, thus influencing everyone who hears Jesus's words toward choosing life for themselves.⁽¹⁸⁾ *Directing and cautioning people to actually hear what Jesus said*^{(40) & (36)} *is the act of preaching of the good news!* It is then

up to each person what to do with that knowledge. ¹⁸ The scriptures that follow more fully explain the "Kingdom of God." They help you <u>understand</u> "the Kingdom" includes *all the individuals* who have heard God⁽²⁸⁾ and are submitting to his son; starting by knowing, of course, what Jesus teaches. ^{19 & (42 – note John 12:50)} Please consider: In the face of the tribulation destroying this world, why aren't the churches recognizing and sharing Jesus's warning about the "signs" we see being indicators of the time of the end? ⁽²⁶⁾ Is it that they don't know, or are they just more interested in keeping up "business as usual," than in telling the truth? ⁽²³⁾ & ⁽⁴⁰⁾ Have they all become just another part of Satan's world, actually working to keep truth hidden? [1 John 5:19 of 18-21]

To begin with, however, who am I that I should say such things? Let me be clear what I am: I am a student of the Bible. Talking about the Bible is the passion of my life (or maybe just the only place I find peace) and I do so every opportunity. Recently, during one such conversation, Max Worthington (an old friend from my youth in the military) asked if I "teach Sunday School or something." I got the sense Max wanted to know if I am a preacher, or what credentials I imagine qualify me to speak so boldly in the name of Jesus. My credentials are simple: I am a Christian²⁰ and I believe in the Bible; with special attention directed to the words of Jesus himself. What I say is simply my best attempt to parrot what I have learned from God's son. I am a plagiarist and my attempt is to speak nothing of my own originality. Knowing Jesus's words, it would be very unwise for me to get to viewing myself as a teacher, or certainly, for me to encourage others to look up to me as such. Jesus did warn about that very thing: He warned against taking or accepting "elevated titles" for ourselves. We all have Jesus as our one and only teacher. Understanding that, I do all I can to direct people to read the Gospels, thus making themselves part of Jesus's family; Amaking themselves God's children by listening to his son as their chosen teacher.

¹⁸ Deuteronomy 30:15-16 ESV (15) "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil. (16) If you obey the commandments of the LORD your God that I command you today, by loving the LORD your God, by walking in his ways, and by keeping his commandments and his statutes and his rules, ⁽²⁸⁾ then you shall live and multiply, and the LORD your God will bless you in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

Recognizing Christ to be our *one and only* teacher, then, I have started actually listening to Jesus; doing so by simply reading the Gospels. The result of that effort is the basis of what you are reading! Based on what Jesus said, I believe we are witnessing the end of this old world system, but, and *this is very important for everyone to understand, "the end" is not a bad thing if you love God!*²⁶ (Note Luke 21:28)

Jesus said ours are like the days of Noah and Lot.²⁷ God told Noah to build an Ark for salvation. He obeyed and he lived! God told Lot to flee the wicked and depraved city of Sodom. He obeyed and he lived! Today, God has told us to listen to his son.²⁸ Therefore, if you follow the example of Noah and Lot, by obeying God's command to listen to Jesus,⁽²⁸⁾ your faith will keep you alive as theirs did them. ⁽⁸⁾ Question: Could you have been deceived, only thinking you were listening to Jesus?^{(40) & (36)} Key: If you are part of a church that even hints your salvation is in any way connected with membership in their sect, you are surely putting those men above Christ! Do you and I foolishly direct people to join our Church, or wisely, to join Jesus himself by actually sitting at his feet; by reading the Gospel accounts of his life and teachings inspired recorded by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John?⁽¹²⁾ All the churches I am aware of seem only about memberships and money and control; and, they can't continue to fleece money from their sheep if they let their worshipers realize reading the Gospels and following Christ is God's one latter day command.^{29 & (28) & (15)} The truth Jesus spoke takes away the need for organized religion and their "celebrated" teachers.⁽²³⁾ No person who knows the truth in Jesus feels any need for a high titled preacher or a glass cathedral. Christians are set free of such pagan beliefs.³⁰ They recognize pomp and circumstance in the

Matthew 24:14 GNB And this Good News about the Kingdom will be preached through all the world for a witness to all people; and then the end will come.

Luke 21:25-28 GNB "There will be strange things happening to the sun, the moon, and the stars. On earth whole countries will be in despair, afraid of the roar of the sea and the raging tides. (26) People will faint from fear as they wait for what (the tribulation that) is coming over the whole earth, for the powers in space will be driven from their courses. (27) Then the Son of Man will appear, coming in a cloud with great power and glory. [Jesus has appeared in the clouds and is doing a separating work in the earth but only those with eyes of faith can see.] (28) When these things begin to happen, stand up and raise your heads, because your salvation is near."

Matthew 24:3-8 NWT ³ While he was sitting upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples approached him privately, saying: "Tell us, When will these things be, and what will be the sign of your presence and of the conclusion of the system of things?" ⁴ And in answer Jesus said to them: "Look out that nobody misleads YOU; ⁵ for many will come on the basis of my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will mislead many. ⁶ YOU are going to hear of wars and reports of wars; see that YOU are not terrified. For these things must take place, but the end is not yet. 7 "For nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be food shortages and earthquakes in one place after another. 8 All these things are a beginning of pangs of distress.

Luke 21:7-13 GNB "Teacher," they asked, "when will this be? And what will happen in order to show that the time has come for it to take place?" (8) Jesus said, "Watch out; don't be fooled. Many men, claiming to speak for me, will come and say, 'I am he!' and, 'The time has come!' But don't follow them. (9) Don't be afraid when you hear of wars and revolutions; such things must happen first, but they do not mean that the end is near." (10) He went on to say, "Countries will fight each other; kingdoms will attack one another. (11) There will be terrible earthquakes, famines, and plagues everywhere; there will be strange and terrifying things coming from the sky. (12) Before all these things take place, however, you will be arrested and persecuted; you will be handed over to be tried in synagogues and be put in prison; you will be brought before kings and rulers for my sake. (13) This will be your chance to tell the Good News.

midst of ornate buildings are no more an aid to true worship than the stones and chicken bones some use in their pagan worship. (That is not to diminish the importance of the Bible. Any church that in any way directs people to the Bible is at least doing that much good; even if they aren't teaching their followers to actually listen to Christ. Some of their sheep, like me, may then pick up a Bible and hear God's command^{(28) & (15)} to listen to his son. If people are not specifically directing others to "really" listen to Christ, though, they are not true Christians!) It is hard for me to understand how I can join or support a church, without implying membership in that group is beneficial to, or even part of, proper worship. It isn't! And since it isn't, why join? Churches just distract from recognizing the simple truth of our need to listen actually and personally to God's son. How could I value membership in some group of men without also foolishly worrying about that sect's approval (or disapproval) of me? [John 5:44; 1 Cor 4:3 in 1-5]⁽⁴¹⁾ This is the exciting truth: Jesus said we must each one worship "in spirit and truth," as individuals.³¹ What does that even mean? Simple! We worship in spirit because Jesus told us no one can come and really listen to him unless they are first drawn by his Father's spirit.³² Then, we worship in truth because Jesus came to bring truth;³³ and we take in God's spirit through the words of Christ.³⁴

This is really simple: If you are actually listening to Jesus instead of men, you *can* understand these things. This is the most exciting time in all human history: The promises from Job are being fulfilled.³⁵ And, it is only a simple thing God has asked of you: All you need do is follow his command to listen to his son.^{(28) & (15)} Few people, however, seem able to comprehend what that really means. They are mostly confused to believe it means working out their own salvation through some group religious association or membership. Many of them seem sincere and maybe mean well.⁽³⁶⁾ *God's command to listen to his son does not, however, mean listening to some preacher. People remain workers of lawlessness until they comprehend their need to direct other persons to hear Christ for themselves.*³⁶ All Christians need to <u>understand</u>: There are no lords or great teachers among us.⁽²³⁾ *While continuing to extend kindness and to help others when able, we all need to listen to Christ Jesus by reading the Gospels and directing others to that one same source of "the good news of the kingdom."^(15 & 28) Understand: The good news of the kingdom is the sum total of the knowledge wrapped up in Jesus Christ!*

John 4:21-23 ESV Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe me, the hour is coming when neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem will you worship the Father. (22) You worship what you do not know; (this woman was a Samaritan, but this applies to any of the many forms of sectarian worship, including some calling themselves "Christian")(see footnote 36) we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews (Jesus was born from the Jewish nation so Christianity is the fulfillment of Judaism). (23) But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him.

³² John 6:44 ALT "No one is able to come to Me unless the Father having sent Me draws [or, drags] him...

³³ John 18:37 GNB ... I was born and came into the world for this one purpose, to speak about the truth. Whoever belongs to the truth listens to me."

Job 33:22-30 GNB they are about to go to the world of the dead. (23) Perhaps an angel may come to their aid-one of God's thousands of angels, who remind us of our duty. (24) In mercy the angel will say, "Release
them! They are not to go down to the world of the dead. Here is the ransom to set them free." (25) Their
bodies will grow young and strong again; (26) when they pray, God will answer; they will worship God with
joy; God will set things right for them again. (27) Each one will say in public, "I have sinned. I have not done
right, but God spared me. (28) He kept me from going to the world of the dead, and I am still alive." (29)
God does all this again and again; (30) each one saves a person's life, and gives him the joy of living.

Get away from me, YOU workers of lawlessness.

So... Like it or not, you are caught in the midst of a spiritual war.³⁷ Pretending it isn't happening doesn't change a thing. It is happening! And, whether you ignore it or not, you are choosing a side.⁽¹⁸⁾ The choice you are making is simple: Either you realize *your own* need, and are helping other people see *their* need, to pick up a Bible and read the words of Christ³⁸ from Matthew, Mark, Luke or John; or, you are looking to and directing people to some other solution. The other solution might be church membership or political affiliation or gang association or any of the thousands of other choices. We see people willfully lie and fight (*in vain*) in support of their Bible condemned sexual orientation, [1 Cor 6:9-11] or for their race or their family, or for any of many other human causes.^{(2) & (27)} Society can only function as long as there is a consensus for rule of law. Make no mistake, radicals who burn cities to defy law are ready to tear down society to get their own way. It will get worse,⁽⁴³⁾ but faith can protect *you*. The thousands of other choices available are all really the one same sad choice, they are *the choice not to follow God's command* to listen to his son.^{(38) & (28)} And that, my friend, is why none of the churches are warning people, or even talking about, the tribulation destroying our world. Either they don't know God's simple command to listen to and exercise faith in the promises of his son,⁽²⁸⁾ or, they don't want to lose their control over you to fleece you of your valuables (*your money and your effort and preaching (work) in support of their seet-your worship of them*). Hearing and following the words of Christ will set you free of all such slavery.^{39 & (30)}

JustBibleTruth.com is a website I support for the sole purpose of helping people recognize their need to actually hear the words of Christ. In all fairness to those who don't like JustBibleTruth.com, Christ's words can (at first) seem a little harsh toward religious sects. Many people have been members of some sect for most or all of their lives... Even so, I remain convinced everyone has to understand group religion can't help⁽¹⁸⁾ (at best they can't help). He but I do also know, it can take some time to let go of misunderstandings we have been taught all our lives (assuming we have the time to let go of those lies). I've been a member of several churches over the years, and associated with even more. From personal experience, then, I know it is hard to realize those organizations we have joined to put faith in are actually distracting us from the teachings of Christ, teaching sectarian doctrines. One thing I am sure is that God will help everyone who will allow themselves to be helped; myself included!

hear. Religionists assert I seek to find fault with their faith and am not loving and forgiving. Truth is, I'm trying not to judge anyone at all. That said, we every one need to be told: Jesus Christ did warn us "his words" are *judging each of us.* ⁴² More accurately, we are each judging ourselves by our response to Christ's words. Since *Jesus said* our response to his teachings is our judge, how can we favorably judge ourselves if we don't begin by accurately knowing what Christ said. [Rev 17:3-18:8] That two headed false God is the cause of, or at best turn a blind eve to, acts such as humanity's spending millions of dollars (per individual game and per player, mind you) to keep grown men playing football to empty stadiums while half the world's population doesn't have enough to eat and a decent place to live. How long did mankind did you really imagine God would ignore such abuse and suffering?
